

BYLAW NO. 2009 – 7

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ROCANVILLE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON PUBLIC ROADWAYS WITHIN CORPORATE TOWN LIMITS.

The Council of the Town of Rocanville, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) “municipality” means the Town of Rocanville;
 - b) “public land” means public land as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act;
 - c) “public roadway” means a “highway” as defined in The Traffic Safety Act and includes any public roadway designed and/or intended for use by the general public for the passage of vehicles within the corporate Town limits.
2. It shall be lawful to operate a Golf Cart during the hours between sunrise and one half hour after sunset on all public roadways.
3. Persons operating a Golf Cart on public roadways must be using the Golf Cart for the sole purpose of transportation to and from the Rocanville Town & Country Golf Course, by the most direct route between the golf course and the driver’s destination.
4. Golf Carts shall display a reflective triangle (slow moving warning device) at the rear, as near to the centre of the Golf Cart as practical and not less than 300 millimeters (1 foot) nor more than 1200 millimeters (4 feet) from the ground.
5. No person shall operate a Golf Cart on public roadways without a valid driver’s licence.
6. All personal and public liability will be the responsibility of the owner/operator of the said Golf Cart.
7. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00.
8. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval by the Highway Traffic Board.
